School Reorganisation Proposal – Amalgamation of Kimberley and Fairoak Nursery Schools

Options Considered/Reasons for Decision

This report referenced the requirement to move to formal consultation on the proposal to amalgamate Newport's two remaining standalone nursery schools - Kimberley Nursery School and Fairoak Nursery School - into a single school on the Fairoak Nursery School site from September 2021.

Since September 2018, the substantive Headteacher of Fairoak Nursery School managed both schools under an Executive Headteacher arrangement. Take-up of places at the schools over recent years was around 50% of the respective Published Admission Numbers. Kimberley Nursery School was operating with a deficit budget for the last three years. This deficit was projected to be approximately £75,000 at the end of the 2019-20 financial year.

There was a requirement to move to the formal consultation stage of the statutory consultation process. The formal consultation pack would include further information regarding the proposal to enable all consultees and stakeholders to be fully informed of the proposals for the new school.

Decision

To move to a period of formal consultation on a school reorganisation proposal to amalgamate Kimberley Nursery School and Fairoak Nursery School into a single nursery school on the current Fairoak site from September 2021.
