Admission to Reception September 2024 - analysis of admissions round as at 16/04/2024

Where a school is named in a statement of Special Educational Needs/Individual Development Plan, the Council has a duty to admit the child to the named setting before the over-subscription criteria is applied against applications received. This reduces the amount of places available to other applicants. Where the total number of preferences for admission to a school has exceeded the number of places available, the following order of priority has been applied to allocate the available places:

- 1. Looked-after children (children in public care) and previously looked-after children
- 2. Pupils living within the catchment area making an application on medical grounds
- 3. Pupils living within the catchment area with relevant siblings
- 4. Pupils living within the catchment area
- 5. Pupils living outside of the catchment area making an application on medical grounds
- 6. Pupils living outside of the catchment area with relevant siblings
- 7. Pupils living outside of the catchment area
